 materials in proportion to the volumes handled, working towards established, documented and

- Try to minimize and safely dispose waste produced by its activities, applying best available techniques, including recovery, reuse and recycle where possible,
- Establish, document and review environmental programs that guides and improves its environmental performance, focuses on prevention of pollution, and pays due regard to nature conservation
- Inform, educate and encourage all staff to actively regard the environment in their daily work and to engage in activities of environmental protection in area of responsibility
