ABOUT

The second largest shipping lines call on the Port of Igoumenitsa, connecting direct and indirect the port westbound and eastbound, to more than 50 countries. With no doubt is one of the E.U. and Greece as well main sea gateways located in Adriatic & Ionian Sea basin. Acting as the connecting point of the mostly unknown, untouched and unspoiled region in E.U. and Greece, with amazing sea promenades with green inlets consisting the Ionian Sea fjords and full of culture, history and culinary tradition inland. The Port of Igoumentisa presents to the shipping community the new era with an extensive master plan full of green technology and innovation, ready to deliver excellent services with shore power (planning for late 2022 season), LNG provision (planning for 2024), updated cruise port operations with Terminal facilities.

Ideal for year-round cruising, Igoumenitsa enjoys a mild Mediterranean climate, with less than 34 rainy days, a lot of sunny days and a warm climate from April to October.

Throughout the year it offers plenty of excursions and activities within a short driving distance from the port having direct access to the Egnatia Highway (A2) one of the main EU highways. There is high potential for pre- and post-cruise packages, thanks to the high number of resort hotels and the port's proximity to the city center and world famous resort areas.



As the 2nd busiest multi-day multipurpose port in Greece and one of the Mediterranean Sea main sea gateways, naturally our sights are set on the next day. But we have more than dreams; we have factual reasons and plans to feel confident of reaching soon this goal.

We are ready to service the demand and the increasing traffic in our region. We have the necessary deep-water channel, convenient access to drive-in with Egnatia Highway and fly-in markets accessing 3 regional international airports and, most of all, we are the only established multipurposed port in Greece with space for significant expansion.

In addition to having the space for growth, we have the financial strength to invest in our future. This is a Port with a strong, stable balance sheet that is not reliant upon government funding. We have in operation two Terminals, Terminal 1 & Terminal 2 and in few months the newest Terminal 3 dedicated for cruise operations. Sustainability isn't only part of our philosophy but we working seriously on that with an intensive master plan with shore power installations, LNG bunkering, Batteries recharging stations, etc.



ON THE WAY TO THE NEW NORMALITY

Timing is critical; the opportunity and challenges are great. We are right on course, building and planning new facilities to attract ships and visitors.
